A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws - Use of Mobile Telephone by Driver Who Is a Minor -**
3 **Prohibition**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a driver of a motor vehicle who is a minor from using
5 a mobile telephone while the vehicle is in motion; providing an exception;
6 providing a penalty for the use of a mobile telephone under prohibited
7 circumstances; including hand-held and hands-free mobile telephones in the
8 prohibition; and generally relating to prohibiting a certain driver of a motor
9 vehicle from using a mobile telephone while the vehicle is in motion.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article - Transportation**

23 21-1123.

24 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "MOBILE TELEPHONE" INCLUDES BOTH HAND-HELD
25 AND HANDS-FREE MOBILE TELEPHONE DEVICES.

26 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A DRIVER OF
27 A MOTOR VEHICLE WHO IS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS MAY NOT OPERATE A
28 MOBILE TELEPHONE WHILE THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS IN MOTION.

1 (C) SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A DRIVER UNDER
2 THE AGE OF 18 YEARS CALLING THE 911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM OR A
3 PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCY IN CONNECTION WITH AN EMERGENCY.

5 (a) It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of the provisions of the
6 Maryland Vehicle Law unless the violation:

7 (1) Is declared to be a felony by the Maryland Vehicle Law or by any
8 other law of this State; or

9 (2) Is punishable by a civil penalty under the applicable provision of the
10 Maryland Vehicle Law.

11 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any person convicted of a
12 misdemeanor for the violation of any of the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law is
13 subject to a fine of not more than \$500.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
15 effect October 1, 2004.
