SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 25 - County Commissioners

- 3 (A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF
- 4 DORCHESTER COUNTY MAY ADOPT AN ORDINANCE, RESOLUTION, OR REGULATION
- 5 OR TAKE ANY OTHER ACTION THAT THE COUNTY COUNCIL CONSIDERS NECESSARY
- 6 TO PROTECT A PERSON'S RIGHT AUTHORIZE A PERSON TO:
- 7 (1) <u>USE THE PERSON'S PERSONAL PROPERTY OR REAL ESTATE TO</u>
- 8 OPERATE A SEAFOOD BUSINESS;
- 9 (2) BUY OR SELL SEAFOOD;
- 10 (3) STORE EQUIPMENT USED IN THE PERSON'S SEAFOOD BUSINESS;
- 11 (4) ENJOY THE QUIET CONDUCT OF THE PERSON'S SEAFOOD BUSINESS
- 12 IN CONFORMANCE WITH COUNTY AND STATE REQUIREMENTS; AND
- 13 (5) HARVEST SEAFOOD.
- 14 (B) BEFORE ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE, RESOLUTION, OR REGULATION
