- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, That:
- 19 (a) (1) The Department of Natural Resources shall authorize the study of
- 20 the Suminoe oyster (Crassostrea ariakensis) and other nonnative species by both
- 21 private and public research institutions with expertise in the field.

1 (2) The study required under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall 2 INCLUDE:

3 (i) [Include an<del>] AN</del> analysis of the ecological benefits and risks 4 associated with the introduction of:

51.Reproductively capable nonnative oyster species in6Maryland waters, for purposes of fisheries restoration or any other purpose; and

72.Sterile nonnative species in Maryland, for purposes of the8 development of aquaculture or any other purpose; and

9 (ii) [Proceed in accordance with] TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE AS THE
 10 STUDY PROGRESSES, <u>BE CONSISTENT WITH</u> the findings of the National Academy of
 11 Sciences review of the Suminoe oyster.

12 (d) The Department shall submit to the Governor and, in accordance with §
13 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the House Environmental Matters
14 Committee and the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee:

15 (1) By December 1, 2002, an interim report on the status of ongoing 16 research and all interim findings available to the Department, including findings to 17 date of the National Academy of Sciences review of the Suminoe oyster; and

18 (2) By December 1, 2004, a final report on all findings available to date 19 from the National Academy of Sciences review and from studies conducted under this 20 Act.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 June 1, 2004.
