### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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#### Wicomico County - Alcoholic Beverages - Licenses and Open Containers

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue a

4 caterer's license to a holder of a Class B restaurant or hotel (on-sale) beer and

- 5 wine license; authorizing the Board to issue a special festival license for
- 6 participation in a beer festival on a nonlicensed premises in the county;
- 7 specifying the qualifications, scope, fee, and time restriction for a special festival
- 8 license; requiring that the products to be displayed and sold by a special festival
- 9 license holder be of a certain type; authorizing the Board to adopt certain
- 10 regulations and to designate the number of times that a special festival license
- 11 may be issued; providing that a special festival license holder is not prohibited

12 from holding another alcoholic beverages license; specifying that certain licenses

- 13 issued in the county are not subject to certain writs or a distraint for rent;
- 14 prohibiting a person from possessing an alcoholic beverage in an open container
- 15 while in certain areas in Wicomico County unless authorized; making stylistic

16 changes; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Wicomico County.

7 (J) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE HOLDER OF THE LICENSE FROM
8 HOLDING ANOTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OF A DIFFERENT CLASS OR
9 NATURE.

10 (K) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

(a) [Licenses] EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION,
 13 LICENSES issued under provisions of this article shall not be regarded as property or
 14 as conferring any property rights. All such licenses shall be subject to suspension,

15 restriction or revocation, and to all rules and regulations that may be adopted as

16 herein provided.

# 17 (F) IN WICOMICO COUNTY, LICENSES ISSUED UNDER THIS ARTICLE ARE NOT 18 SUBJECT TO WRITS OF EXECUTION BY A JUDGMENT CREDITOR OF A LICENSEE OR A 19 DISTRAINT FOR RENT.

- 21 (a) (1) This definition applies only in the following jurisdictions:
- 22 (i) Caroline County;
- 23 (ii) Carroll County;
- 24 (iii) Dorchester County;
- 25 (iv) Harford County; [and]
- 26 (v) Montgomery County; AND
- 27 (VI) WICOMICO COUNTY.

28 (2) In this section "unless authorized" means the possession and 29 presentation of a written consent by the owner of the property.

30 (b) A person may not possess in an open container any alcoholic beverage, as 31 defined in this article, while:

(1) On the mall, adjacent parking area, or other outside area of any
 combination of privately owned retail establishments, commonly known as a shopping

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center, to which the general public is invited for business purposes, unless authorized
 by the owner of the establishment;

3 (2) On an adjacent parking area or other outside area of any other retail 4 establishment, unless authorized by the owner of the establishment; or

5 (3) In any parked vehicle located on any of the places enumerated in this 6 section, unless authorized.

8 Any person who violates the provisions of this [subheading] SUBTITLE is guilty 9 of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$100.

10 19-303.

11 This [subheading] SUBTITLE applies only in the following counties:

12 (1) Allegany County;

13 (2) Baltimore County, including motorcycles located on any of the places 14 enumerated in § 19-301 of this [subheading] SUBTITLE, unless authorized;
