- 9 individuals to meet certain requirements to qualify to administer and interpret

- education requirements as a condition of license renewal; requiring the Board to
- designate certain individuals who meet certain requirements with certain titles;
- requiring certain individuals to be licensed by the Board to administer and
- interpret certain instruments before using certain titles and making certain
- representations; requiring the Board to submit a certain report to the Governor
- and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; defining certain terms;

- 12 guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500 or
- 13 imprisonment not exceeding 6 months or both.

- 15 [(d)] (E) This subtitle may not be construed to limit the scope of practice of 16 any individual who is duly licensed under this article.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the State Board of
- 18 Professional Counselors and Therapists shall report to the Governor and, in
- 19 accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly on
- 20 or before October 1, 2008 on the implementation of this Act and any recommendations
- 21 for legislative or regulatory action.
- 22 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 23 October 1, 2004.
