1 AN ACT concerning

2 Motor Vehicle Liability Insurance - Valuation of Motor Vehicles - Disclosure

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that certain regulations require each insurer to file
- 4 with the Insurance Commissioner the condition inspection guidelines that the
- 5 insurer uses in the settlement of claims involving a determination of the total
- 6 loss of a private passenger motor vehicle; requiring the regulations to require an
- 7 insurer to disclose to a certain claimant certain guidelines and valuation; and
- 8 generally relating to the disclosure of guidelines and valuation of motor vehicles
- 9 under motor vehicle liability insurance.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article - Insurance

- 19 (A) The Commissioner shall adopt regulations that establish standards and
- 20 procedures for:
- 21 (1) the settlement of claims involving the total loss of a private
- 22 passenger motor vehicle; and
- 23 (2) the determination of the private passenger motor vehicle's total loss
- 24 value.
- 25 (B) (1) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL REQUIRE
- 26 EACH INSURER TO FILE WITH THE COMMISSIONER THE CONDITION INSPECTION
- 27 GUIDELINES THAT THE INSURER USES IN THE SETTLEMENT OF CLAIMS INVOLVING
- 28 A DETERMINATION OF THE TOTAL LOSS OF A PRIVATE PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLE.

SENATE BILL 735

- 1 (2) THE REGULATIONS SHALL REQUIRE AN INSURER, UPON REQUEST, 2 TO DISCLOSE TO A CLAIMANT WHO HAS FILED A CLAIM INVOLVING THE TOTAL LOSS
- 3 OF A PRIVATE PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLE:
- 4 (I) THE CONDITION INSPECTION GUIDELINES THAT THE INSURER
- 5 USED TO DETERMINE THE TOTAL LOSS VALUE OF THE PRIVATE PASSENGER MOTOR
- 6 VEHICLE; AND
- 7 (II) THE VALUATION OF THE PRIVATE PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLE 8 IN RELATION TO THE CONDITION INSPECTION GUIDELINES.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2004.
