- 16 (A) The Board of Trustees shall grant an ordinary disability retirement 17 allowance to a member if:
- 18 (1) the member has at least 5 years of eligibility service; and
- 19 (2) the medical board certifies that:
- 20 (i) the member is mentally or physically incapacitated for the
- 21 further performance of the normal duties of the member's position;
- 22 (ii) the incapacity is likely to be permanent; and
- 23 (iii) the member should be retired.

- 7 FOR A SPECIAL DISABILITY ON BEHALF OF THE MEMBER UNDER § 29-103 OF THIS
- 8 SUBTITLE OR § 2-415 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE, ON OR BEFORE MAY 1, 1993;
- 9 (3) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES DENIED THE MEMBER A SPECIAL
- 10 DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER § 29-111 OF THIS SUBTITLE, ON OR
- 11 BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 1995;
- 12 (4) THE MEMBER WITHDREW THE MEMBER'S ACCUMULATED
- 13 CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM ON OR BEFORE
- 14 NOVEMBER 1, 1996; AND
- 15 ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2004, THE MEMBER PAYS TO THE
- 16 BOARD OF TRUSTEES IN A SINGLE PAYMENT THE MEMBER'S ACCUMULATED
- 17 CONTRIBUTIONS THAT WERE WITHDRAWN FROM THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT
- 18 SYSTEM ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 1, 1996.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 20 July 1, 2004.
