- 3 FOR the purpose of exempting certain bed and breakfast establishments from certain
- 4 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and local government regulations
- 5 relating to a certain type of kitchen equipment; requiring certain bed and
- 6 breakfast establishments to register with the health officer in the county be
- 7 <u>licensed by the Department;</u> providing that certain bed and breakfast
- 8 establishments are subject to certain food safety and contamination regulations;
- 9 requiring the health officer in each county where a certain bed and breakfast
- establishment is registered to inspect the bed and breakfast establishment for
- 11 compliance with certain food safety and contamination regulations; and
- 12 generally relating to the regulation of food service at bed and breakfast

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article - Health - General

- 3 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "BED AND BREAKFAST ESTABLISHMENT" MEANS A
- 4 LODGING OR ROOMING HOUSE AS DEFINED IN § 9-201 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY
- 5 ARTICLE HAVING EIGHT FIVE ROOMS OR LESS FOR RENT.
- 6 (B) A BED AND BREAKFAST ESTABLISHMENT IS EXEMPT FROM ANY
- 7 REGULATION GOVERNING FOOD SERVICE FACILITIES THAT IS ADOPTED BY THE
- 8 DEPARTMENT OR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OR
- 9 INSTALLATION OF COMMERCIAL GRADE KITCHEN EQUIPMENT IN THE BED AND
- 10 BREAKFAST ESTABLISHMENT.
- 11 (C) EACH BED AND BREAKFAST ESTABLISHMENT THAT INTENDS TO SERVE
- 12 HOT MEALS TO RENTERS SHALL BE REGISTERED WITH THE HEALTH OFFICER FOR
- 13 THE COUNTY LICENSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 21-305 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND IS
- 14 SUBJECT TO STATE AND LOCAL HEALTH REGULATIONS THAT GOVERN FOOD SAFETY
- 15 AND CONTAMINATION.
- 16 (D) IN EACH COUNTY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 21-313 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE
- 17 HEALTH OFFICER SHALL INSPECT EACH BED AND BREAKFAST ESTABLISHMENT
- 18 THAT INTENDS TO SERVE HOT MEALS TO RENTERS FOR COMPLIANCE WITH FOOD
- 19 SAFETY AND CONTAMINATION REGULATIONS.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 21 October 1, 2004.
