- 16 A PERSON MAY NOT CHARGE A CONSUMER FOR CONSUMER GOODS OR
- 17 CONSUMER SERVICES UNLESS THE CONSUMER AGREES IN WRITING TO PAY FOR THE
- 18 CONSUMER GOODS OR CONSUMER SERVICES.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 20 October 1, 2004.
