A BILL ENTITLED

- 2 Creation of a State Debt Prince George's County Rollingcrest-Chillum
 3 Community Center
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- \$500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Rollingcrest/Chillum
- 6 Recreation Council and the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning
- 7 Commission for certain development or improvement purposes; providing for
- 8 disbursement of the loan proceeds; establishing a deadline for the encumbrance
- 9 or expenditure of the loan proceeds; and providing generally for the issuance
- and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 12 MARYLAND, That:
- 13 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 14 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince
- 15 George's County Rollingcrest-Chillum Community Center Loan of 2004 in the total
- 16 principal amount of \$500,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and
- 17 delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of
- 18 Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through
- 19 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 20 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 21 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 22 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 23 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 24 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 25 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 26 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 27 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 28 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Rollingcrest/Chillum Recreation
- 29 Council and the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission for the
- 30 planning, design, and construction of an addition to the Rollingcrest-Chillum
- 31 Community Center, located in Chillum.

- 1 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 2 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 3 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 4 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 5 (5) The proceeds of the loan must be expended or encumbered by the Board of
- 6 Public Works for the purposes provided in this Act no later than June 1, 2011. If any
- 7 funds authorized by this Act remain unexpended or unencumbered after June 1, 2011,
- 8 the amount of the unencumbered or unexpended authorization shall be canceled and
- 9 be of no further effect. If bonds have been issued for the loan, the amount of
- 10 unexpended or unencumbered bond proceeds shall be disposed of as provided in §
- 11 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 June 1, 2004.
