- 5 that the regulations provide for certain registrations, background checks, and
- 6 surety bonds; requiring the Department to register certain individuals;
- 7 requiring certain chore and companion service agencies to conduct certain
- 8 background checks and maintain certain surety bonds; prohibiting an individual
- 9 who is not registered under this Act from operating, attempting to operate, or
- 10 holding one's self out as operating certain chore and companion service agencies;
- providing for certain penalties; defining certain terms; and generally relating to
- the registration of chore and companion service agencies.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 24 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS

- 26 (B) "CHORE AND COMPANION SERVICES" MEANS:
- 27 (1) HOME MANAGEMENT;

- 2 (3) SHOPPING; AND
- 3 (4) OTHER HOUSEHOLD-RELATED ERRANDS.
- 4 (C) "CHORE AND COMPANION SERVICE AGENCY" MEANS AN AGENCY THAT
- 5 REFERS INDIVIDUALS TO THE HOME OF A SICK OR DISABLED INDIVIDUAL TO
- 6 PERFORM CHORE AND COMPANION SERVICES.

- 8 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT SET STANDARDS
- 9 FOR THE CARE, TREATMENT, HEALTH, SAFETY, WELFARE, AND COMFORT OF
- 10 INDIVIDUALS WHO RECEIVE CHORE AND COMPANION SERVICES THROUGH A CHORE
- 11 AND COMPANION SERVICE AGENCY.

- 21 A CHORE AND COMPANION SERVICE AGENCY SHALL:
- 22 (1) CONDUCT CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS OF THE INDIVIDUALS IT

- 24 (2) MAINTAIN A SURETY BOND IN THE FORM AND AMOUNT
- 25 DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT THROUGH REGULATION.

- 27 AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT OPERATE. ATTEMPT TO OPERATE. OR HOLD ONE'S
- 28 SELF OUT AS OPERATING A CHORE AND COMPANION SERVICE AGENCY, UNLESS THE
- 29 INDIVIDUAL IS REGISTERED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

- 31 (A) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO OPERATES A CHORE AND COMPANION SERVICE
- 32 AGENCY WITHOUT A REGISTRATION OR IN VIOLATION OF THE REGULATIONS

- 1 ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON
- 2 CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE
- 3 AND NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000 FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE.
- 4 (B) EACH DAY A VIOLATION IS CONTINUED AFTER THE FIRST CONVICTION IS
- 5 A SEPARATE OFFENSE.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 7 October 1, 2004.
