- 12 AND NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000 FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE.
- 13 (B) EACH DAY A VIOLATION IS CONTINUED AFTER THE FIRST CONVICTION IS
- 14 A SEPARATE OFFENSE.
