24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
25 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Correctional Services

2 [8-104.

3 Except as provided in the State budget, State funds may not be used to
4 implement standards for State correctional facilities that are adopted or proposed by
5 the American Correctional Association.]

6 [8-105.] 8-104.

7 The standards adopted under § 8-103 of this subtitle shall be enforced as
8 provided under [§§ 8-112 through 8-114] §§ 8-111 THROUGH 8-113 of this subtitle.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 8-106 through
10 8-117, respectively, of Article - Correctional Services of the Annotated Code of
11 Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 8-105 through 8-116, respectively.

12 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 on October 1, 2004.
