A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State Board of Education from requiring students
- 4 to perform community service as a condition of graduation from a public high
- school in the State; and generally relating to community service and graduation

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Education
- 15 7-205.
- 16 (a) The promotion of students in a public school and graduation from a public
- 17 high school shall be in accordance with:
- 18 (1) Policies established by the county board; and
- 19 (2) The rules and regulations of the State Board.
- 20 (b) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE STATE BOARD
- 21 MAY NOT REOUIRE A STUDENT TO PERFORM COMMUNITY SERVICE AS A CONDITION
- 22 OF GRADUATION FROM A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN THE STATE.
- 23 (C) (1) Each student who graduates from a public high school shall receive
- 24 the same type of diploma or certificate, regardless of the high school attended or the
- 25 course taken.

- 1 (2) The diploma or certificate shall state that the student has completed 2 a program of studies satisfactorily in accordance with the requirements of the State
- 3 Board.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 4
- 5 effect July 1, 2004.
