- SECTION 2. 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2004. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of May 31, 2005, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
