## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## Harford County Community College - Board of Trustees - Membership, Officers, and Standing Committee Chairs

FOR the purpose of increasing the membership of the Board of Community College
Trustees for Harford County to include a student member who meets certain qualifications and a member who is a full-time teaching faculty member of the Community College and who is appointed to the Board in accordance with a certain process, both of whom are to serve in a nonvoting capacity; providing for limitations on the length of service on the Board by the student member and the full-time teaching faculty member; requiring the Board to appoint one of its members as secretary of the Board and another of its members as treasurer of the Board; requiring the Board to appoint the chairs of its standing committees from within the Board's membership; requiring the Board to create other standing committees as needed; and generally relating to the Board of Community College Trustees of Harford County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25 (a) Each board of trustees:
(1) Shall elect one of its members as its chairman;

3 serve as secretary-treasurer of the board; and
(3) May elect any other officer it requires.
(b) Each board shall determine the time and place of its meetings and may 6 adopt rules for the conduct of its meetings.

8 (a) (1) The Board of Community College Trustees for Harford County 9 consists of [nine] 11 members.

10 (2) Subject to paragraph (4) of this subsection, each of the members shall 11 be:

21 THE BOARD IN A NONVOTING CAPACITY; AND
(2) THE STUDENT MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL SERVE FOR 1 YEAR.
(3) THE FULL-TIME TEACHING FACULTY MEMBER OF THE BOARD 2 SHALL SERVE FOR 2 CONSECUTIVE YEARS AND MAY BE REELECTED AND 3 REAPPOINTED.

4 (C) THE BOARD SHALL APPOINT FROM WITHIN ITS MEMBERSHIP:

7 (D) (1) THE BOARD SHALL APPOINT FROM WITHIN ITS MEMBERSHIP THE 8 CHAIRS OF THE FOLLOWING STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD:

16 [(c)] (E) At least twice annually, the Board of Community College Trustees,
17 the College President, the Harford County Board of Education, and the
18 Superintendent of the Harford County public schools shall meet to discuss issues of 19 mutual concern.
