- 2 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, THIS
- 3 SUBTITLE APPLIES TO ALL PROCUREMENTS BY A DESIGNATED PROCUREMENT UNIT.
- 4 (B) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO PROCUREMENTS SUBJECT TO

- 6 (B) (C) A DESIGNATED PROCUREMENT UNIT SHALL STRUCTURE ITS

- 16 (A) THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS
- 17 TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR COMPILING AND MAINTAINING A COMPREHENSIVE
- 18 BIDDER'S LIST OF QUALIFIED SMALL BUSINESSES THAT SHALL BE POSTED ON THE
- 19 DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE.
- 20 (B) EACH DESIGNATED PROCUREMENT UNIT SHALL ENSURE COMPLIANCE
- 21 WITH THE REGULATIONS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

- 23 (A) ANY PROCUREMENT BY A DESIGNATED PROCUREMENT UNIT OF GOODS,
- 24 SUPPLIES, SERVICES, MAINTENANCE, CONSTRUCTION, CONSTRUCTION-RELATED
- 25 SERVICES, ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES, AND ENGINEERING SERVICES SHALL BE
- 26 ELIGIBLE FOR DESIGNATION FOR THE SMALL BUSINESS RESERVE.
- 27 (B) A SOLICITATION FOR PROCUREMENT THAT HAS BEEN DESIGNATED FOR A
- 28 SMALL BUSINESS RESERVE SHALL BE PUBLISHED IN THE SAME MANNER AS
- 29 REQUIRED FOR AN INVITATION FOR BIDS AS SET FORTH IN § 13-103(C) OF THIS
- 30 ARTICLE.
- 31 (C) THE PROCUREMENT OFFICER OF A DESIGNATED PROCUREMENT UNIT
- 32 SHALL AWARD A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT DESIGNATED FOR A SMALL BUSINESS
- 33 RESERVE TO THE SMALL BUSINESS THAT SUBMITS A RESPONSIVE BID THAT:
- 34 (1) IS THE LOWEST BID PRICE;
- 35 (2) IF THE INVITATION FOR BIDS SO PROVIDES, IS THE LOWEST
- 36 EVALUATED BID PRICE; OR

- 1 (3) IS THE BID OR PROPOSAL MOST FAVORABLE TO THE STATE WITHIN 2 THE SMALL BUSINESS RESERVE.

- 4 (A) WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE END OF EACH FISCAL YEAR, EACH
- 5 DESIGNATED PROCUREMENT UNIT SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT ON THE OPERATION
- 6 AND EFFECTIVENESS OF THE SMALL BUSINESS RESERVE PROGRAM TO THE BOARD
- 7 OF PUBLIC WORKS.
- 8 (B) WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF ALL REPORTS REQUIRED UNDER
- 9 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS SHALL COMPILE
- 10 THE INFORMATION AND REPORT ON THE ENTIRE SMALL BUSINESS RESERVE
- 11 PROGRAM TO THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE
- 12 STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 14 effect October 1, 2004. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end
- 15 of September 30, 2007, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
- 16 Act, and any regulations adopted under the provisions of this Act, shall be abrogated
- 17 and of no further force and effect.
