A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Agricultural Land Preservation - Termination of Agricultural Districts

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a landowner to terminate the landowner's property
- 4 from an agricultural district after a certain time period has elapsed if the
- 5 Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation has not purchased an
- 6 agricultural preservation easement on the property and the landowner provides
- 7 certain notice to the Foundation in a certain time period; providing that a
- 8 certain termination is not effective until the landowner executes and records the
- 9 termination; and generally relating to agricultural land preservation and the
- 10 termination of agricultural districts.
- 11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 12 Article Agriculture

- 15 (1999 Replacement Volume and 2003 Supplement)
- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 Article - Agriculture

- 20 (b) Regulations and procedures adopted by the Foundation for the
- 21 establishment and monitoring of agricultural districts shall provide that:
- 22 (8) (I) [At] NOTWITHSTANDING SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS
- 23 PARAGRAPH, AT any time after [five] 5 years from the establishment of a district a
- 24 landowner may terminate his property as an agricultural district by notifying the
- 25 Foundation [one] 1 year in advance of his intention to do so.

- 1 (II) 1. AFTER AT LEAST 30 MONTHS HAVE ELAPSED FROM THE
- 2 ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT, A LANDOWNER MAY TERMINATE
- 3 THE LANDOWNER'S PROPERTY AS AN AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT IF:
- 4 A. THE FOUNDATION HAS NOT PURCHASED AN
- 5 AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION EASEMENT ON THE PROPERTY; AND
- 6 B. THE LANDOWNER NOTIFIES THE FOUNDATION OF THE
- 7 LANDOWNER'S INTENT TO TERMINATE THE DISTRICT AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE THE
- 8 TERMINATION.
- 9 2. A TERMINATION OF A PROPERTY AS AN AGRICULTURAL
- 10 DISTRICT UNDER THIS SUBPARAGRAPH IS NOT EFFECTIVE UNTIL THE LANDOWNER
- 11 HAS EXECUTED AND RECORDED THE TERMINATION ALONG WITH LAND RECORDS.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 June 1, 2004.
