Garrett County - Public Local Laws - Obsolete Provisions - Repeal

This bill repeals obsolete provisions of the Public Local Laws of Garrett County pertaining to appliance installers, billiard rooms and bowling alleys, crimes and punishments, firearms, manufacturers and miners, teachers' pensions, the poor or insane, the sheriff, thistles, and wages.

Fiscal Summary

Local Effect: None. Repealing obsolete provisions of Garrett County's public local laws will not affect county finances.

Background: Garrett County advises that the obsolete provisions of the county's Public Local Laws have been preempted by State law, superseded by other local laws and ordinances, or are out-of-date with current circumstances.
