Economic Matters

Prince George's County - Class A Beer, Wine and Liquor Licenses - Sunday Sales - 21st District PG 332-04

This bill authorizes a holder of a Class A beer, wine, and liquor license in the 21st alcoholic beverages district of Prince George's County to sell alcoholic beverages from 6:30 a.m. Sunday to 2 a.m. the following Monday.

The bill takes effect June 1, 2004.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Prince George's County finances would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Analysis

Current Law: In Prince George's County, a holder of a Class A beer, wine, and liquor license or any agent, servant, or employee of the licensee may not sell alcoholic beverages between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. or on Sunday after 2 a.m. except when December 24 and December 31 fall on a Sunday.

Background: The 21st alcoholic beverages district in Prince George's County is the City of Laurel.
