Hospitals - Written Statement - Provider Bills

This bill requires a hospital to provide an individual who is seeking treatment a written statement indicating the individual may receive bills, separate from the hospital's bill, from providers treating the individual at the hospital.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill would not directly affect governmental operations or finances.

Local Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: A hospital or nursing facility must provide written information to an individual, on or before admission, about: (1) the facility's services, including each service that is required to be offered on an as-needed basis; and (2) related charges, including any charges for services that are not covered by Medicare, Medicaid, or the basic rate of the facility.
