**FISCAL AND POLICY NOTE**

House Bill 1338  
Ways and Means

(Delegates Marriott and Goodwin)

**Education - Baltimore City Community College Board of Trustees - Membership**

---

This bill adds a tenth member to the Baltimore City Community College (BCCC) Board of Trustees. The new member must be a member of a collective bargaining unit established at the college and will serve a three-year term beginning on July 1, 2004 and ending on June 30, 2007.

---

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** The bill would not materially affect BCCC's finances. Each trustee is reimbursed for approximately \$1,750 in expenses each year.

**Local Effect:** None.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

---

**Analysis**

**Current Law:** The government of BCCC is vested in a nine-member board of trustees. Each member is appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. Each must be a Maryland resident, and a majority must reside in Baltimore City. One member must be a regularly enrolled student in good standing at the college.

All members except the student member serve staggered six-year terms, starting on July 1 of the year of appointment and ending on June 30 six years later. The student member serves a one-year term. A member may be reappointed, but may not serve more than two consecutive terms.

Members serve without compensation but are reimbursed for expenses. Each year the board elects a nonstudent member as president and may elect any other officers it requires. A majority of the voting members constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business.
