House Bill 1398 Appropriations

Budget and Taxation

Anne Arundel County - Annapolis Maritime Museum Loan of 2001

This bill extends the deadline, from June 1, 2003 to June 1, 2005, for the Board of Directors of Annapolis Maritime Museum, Inc., and the City of Annapolis, as grantees, to provide matching funds for the Anne Arundel County – Annapolis Maritime Museum Loan of 2001.

The bill takes effect June 1, 2004.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Extending the deadline for the provision of matching funds would not materially affect State finances.

Local Effect: The City of Annapolis, as one of the grantees, would be eligible to receive funds authorized by Chapter 239 of 2001.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 239 of 2001 authorized up to \$150,000 in matching funds to the grantees for the planning, design, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of two buildings, located adjacent to each other at 723 Second Street and 133 Bay Shore Drive in Annapolis, for use as a museum.

Background: The grantees have collected funds sufficient to meet the required match in the form of grants from the City of Annapolis and dedicated funds in a bank account. However, the grantees have not filed the required paperwork with the Department of General Services.
