Ways and Means

Carroll County Republican Party Central Committee – Composition

This bill expands the membership of the Carroll County Republican Party Central Committee from seven to nine.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: The Carroll County Board of Elections would be able to implement the bill's requirements using existing budgeted resources.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The Carroll County Republican Central Committee comprises seven members elected at-large.

Background: A principal political party must elect members of a county central committee at a primary election. Five counties currently elect members of local Republican central committees by State legislative or local councilmanic districts. Eighteen counties and Baltimore City have committees comprised of members elected at-large.
