### Correctional Services - Inclusion of Ethnicity of Inmate in Case Record

This bill requires the Division of Correction (DOC) to include a designation of ethnicity in an inmate's case record.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. The requirements of this bill could be handled with the existing budgeted resources of DOC.

Local Effect: None.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

## **Analysis**

**Current Law:** Promptly after an inmate is sentenced to the jurisdiction of DOC, the division must assemble an adequate case record for the inmate that includes: (1) a description of the inmate; (2) a photograph; (3) the family history; (4) any previous record; (5) a summary of the facts of each case for which the inmate is serving a sentence; and (6) the results of the inmate's required physical, mental, and educational examination.
