### State Highways - Designation - Corporal Jason Mileo Memorial Highway

This bill designates the portion of Maryland Route 10 between Interstate 695 and Governor Ritchie Highway in Anne Arundel County as the Corporal Jason Mileo Memorial Highway.

**Background:** Marine Corporal Jason Mileo, a 20-year-old from Centerville, died in combat near Baghdad, Iraq on April 14, 2003 after being mistaken for an enemy soldier. He was assigned to the 3rd Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment, 1st Marine Division.
