#### Harford Community College - Board of Trustees - Membership, Officers, and Standing Committee Chairs

This bill increases, from nine to 11, the membership of the Board of Community College Trustees for Harford County. The bill adds two nonvoting members to be appointed by the Governor – a full-time student member and a full-time teaching faculty member. The student member will serve for one year. The faculty member must be elected by the full-time faculty of the Harford Community College and will serve for two consecutive years and may be reelected and reappointed.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2004.

#### **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** None. The bill would not materially affect Harford Community College finances. Each trustee is entitled to a \$500 stipend for expenses each year. The bill adds two trustees.

Small Business Effect: None.

#### Analysis

**Current Law:** The Board of Community College Trustees for Harford County consists of nine members – six appointed by the Governor from the councilmanic districts (one from each) and three appointed from the county at large. Members serve five-year terms.
