AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 2, AS AMENDED

AMENDMENT NO. 1

In Amendment No. 1 of the Senate Rules Committee Amendments (HB0002/973928/1):

On page 2, strike beginning with "applying" in line 19 down through "organization;" in line 21.

On page 3, strike beginning with "requiring" in line 23 down through "Fund;" in line 25 and substitute "providing for the composition of the Fund; requiring the Governor to include a certain appropriation to the Fund for a certain fiscal year; requiring the Governor to transfer certain amounts to the Fund from a certain special fund for certain fiscal years; requiring the Governor to transfer a certain amount to the General Fund from a certain special fund for a certain fiscal year;".

On page 4, in line 27, strike "15-102.7 and"; and strike in their entirety lines 30 and 31.

On page 5, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 3, inclusive; and in line 11, strike "6-101, 6-102, 6-103, 6-104, 6-107,".

On page 6, strike in their entirety lines 13 through 17, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

In Amendment No. 1 of the Senate Rules Committee Amendments:

On page 17, strike in their entirety lines 2 through 4, inclusive; and strike in their entirety lines 14 through 21, inclusive.

On page 18, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 4, inclusive.

On pages 46 through 50, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 5 on page 46 through line 6 on page 50, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

In Amendment No. 1 of the Senate Rules Committee Amendments:

On pages 58 and 59, strike beginning with "NOTWITHSTANDING" in the last line on page 58 down through "FUND;" in line 11 on page 59 and substitute "THE FUND CONSISTS OF:"

(Over)

1. MONEY TRANSFERRED TO THE FUND;
  2. MONEY APPROPRIATED BY THE STATE TO THE FUND;
  3. INCOME FROM INVESTMENTS THAT THE BOARD MAKES OR AUTHORIZES ON BEHALF OF THE FUND;
  4. INTEREST ON DEPOSITS OR INVESTMENTS OF MONEY FROM THE FUND;
  5. MONEY COLLECTED BY THE BOARD AS A RESULT OF LEGAL OR OTHER ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE BOARD ON BEHALF OF THE FUND;
  6. MONEY DONATED TO THE FUND; AND
  7. MONEY AWARDED TO THE FUND THROUGH GRANTS.
- (II) 1. FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET AN APPROPRIATION TO THE FUND FROM THE GENERAL FUND.
2. FOR EACH OF FISCAL YEARS 2007 AND 2008, THE GOVERNOR SHALL TRANSFER \$30,000,000 TO THE FUND FROM THE CIGARETTE RESTITUTION FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 7-317 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
3. FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009, THE GOVERNOR SHALL TRANSFER \$30,000,000 FROM THE CIGARETTE RESTITUTION FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE."

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 91, strike in their entirety lines 3 through 20, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 5

In Amendment No. 1 of the Senate Rules Committee Amendments:

On page 93, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 3; and in line 4, strike "7." and substitute "5.".
