AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 8, after "circumstances;" insert "<u>prohibiting a person from initiating the transmission of an individual's Social Security number over the Internet under certain circumstances;</u>"; in line 18, strike "before" and substitute "<u>prior to</u>"; and in line 23, after "Act;" insert "providing for a delayed effective date;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 21, after "(B)" insert "<u>"INTERACTIVE COMPUTER SERVICE PROVIDER" MEANS AN ENTITY THAT PROVIDES A SERVICE THAT PROVIDES OR ENABLES COMPUTER ACCESS VIA THE INTERNET BY MULTIPLE USERS TO A COMPUTER SERVER OR SIMILAR DEVICE USED FOR THE STORAGE OF IMAGES, INFORMATION, OR DATA.</u>

(C) (1) "PERSON" INCLUDES AN INDIVIDUAL, CORPORATION, BUSINESS TRUST, ESTATE TRUST, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION, TWO OR MORE PERSONS HAVING A JOINT OR COMMON INTEREST, OR ANY OTHER COMMERCIAL ENTITY.

<u>(2)</u>";

and in line 22, strike "(C)" and substitute "(D)".

On page 4, in line 4, after "(4)" insert "<u>INITIATE THE TRANSMISSION OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OVER THE INTERNET UNLESS THE CONNECTION IS SECURE OR THE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IS ENCRYPTED;</u>

and in line 8, strike "(5)" and substitute "(6)".

On page 5, in line 1, strike "EVIDENT" and substitute "EVIDENCE"; in line 13, strike "JULY" and substitute "JANUARY"; in lines 8 and 13, in each instance, strike "2005" and substitute "2006"; in line 25, strike "July 1, 2005" and substitute "January 1, 2006"; in line 26, strike "the effective date of this Act" and substitute "January 1, 2006"; in lines 27 and 28, strike "no later than July 1, 2006" and substitute "on or before January 1, 2007"; and in line 36, strike "July 1, 2005" and substitute "January 1, 2006. Section 2 of this Act shall remain in effect for a period of 3 years and, at the end of December 31, 2008, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 2 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect".
