AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 351

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 22, after “(11)” insert “and 5-573(b)(7) and (8)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 32, strike “SAFE FOR CONSUMPTION”; and in the same line, after “AUTHORITY” insert “TO BE SAFE FOR CONSUMPTION”.

On page 3, in lines 14 and 15, strike “SAFE FOR CONSUMPTION”; and in line 15, after “AUTHORITY” insert “TO BE SAFE FOR CONSUMPTION”.

On page 5, in line 10, strike the period and substitute “; AND”; in line 11, strike “REQUIREMENTS” and substitute “A REQUIREMENT”; in line 21, strike “SAFE FOR CONSUMPTION”; in line 22, after “AUTHORITY” insert “TO BE SAFE FOR CONSUMPTION”; after line 26, insert:

“(7) prohibit a child from remaining at a child care center for more than 14 hours in 1 day unless the Department issues an exception for that child based on guidelines set by the Secretary; [and]

“(8) (i) require that a child care center have in attendance at all times at least 1 individual who is responsible for supervision of children, including children on field trips, and who holds a current certificate indicating successful completion of approved:

1. basic first aid training through the American Red Cross or through a program with equivalent standards; and

2. cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training through the

American Heart Association or through a program with equivalent standards appropriate for the ages of children for whom care is provided in the child care center; and

(ii) require that a child care center serving more than 20 children have in attendance certificate holders described in item (i) of this item in a ratio of at least 1 certificate holder for every 20 children[.]; AND”;

and in line 32, strike the period and substitute “; AND”.

On page 6, in line 6, strike “SAFE FOR CONSUMPTION”; and in the same line, after “AUTHORITY” insert “TO BE SAFE FOR CONSUMPTION”.
