AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 541

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, in line 2, after “reasons;” insert “establishing that a licensed pharmacist may not be required to dispense emergency contraception or refer a person to a source for emergency contraception; establishing that a licensed pharmacist is not subject to certain civil liability or certain actions for a certain refusal;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 6, in line 14, before “THIS” insert “(A)”; and before line 26, insert:

“(B) (1) A LICENSED PHARMACIST MAY NOT BE REQUIRED TO DISPENSE EMERGENCY CONTRACEPTION, OR REFER A PERSON TO ANY SOURCE FOR EMERGENCY CONTRACEPTION.

(2) THE REFUSAL OF A LICENSED PHARMACIST TO DISPENSE EMERGENCY CONTRACEPTION OR TO REFER A PERSON TO ANY SOURCE FOR EMERGENCY CONTRACEPTION MAY NOT BE A BASIS FOR:

(I) CIVIL LIABILITY TO ANOTHER PERSON; OR

(II) DISCIPLINARY OR OTHER RECRIMINATORY ACTION AGAINST THE LICENSED PHARMACIST.”.
