AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 262

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Delegate Morhaim” and substitute “Delegates Morhaim, Hurson, Hammen, Benson, Boteler, Boutin, Bromwell, Costa, Donoghue, Elliott, Frank, Hubbard, Kach, Kullen, Mandel, Murray, Nathan-Pulliam, Oaks, Pendergrass, Rudolph, V. Turner, and Weldon”; and strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 4 down through “debarment” in line 5 and substitute “providing for the automatic termination of a certain debarment”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 11, strike “OR SUSPENSION”; and in line 12, strike “PERSON DEBARRED MAY PETITION THE BOARD FOR REMOVAL OF THE DEBARMENT” and substitute “DEBARMENT TERMINATES AUTOMATICALLY IF THE PERSON DEBARRED PROVIDES TO THE BOARD SUFFICIENT LEGAL DOCUMENTATION THAT THE FEDERAL DEBARMENT HAS BEEN REVERSED OR OTHERWISE RENDERED VOID”.
