AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 802

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “requiring” in line 18 down through “court;” in line 19; and in line 27, after “terms;” insert “requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, in coordination with other appropriate State agencies, to work with the Judiciary to develop certain training for certain individuals; providing for a delayed effective date;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 9, strike beginning with the colon in line 10 down through “(1)” in line 11; in lines 12 and 15, strike “(I)” and “(II)”, respectively, and substitute “(1)” and “(2)”, respectively; and strike beginning with “; AND” in line 16 down through “FACILITY” in line 19.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 10, after line 18, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, beginning June 1, 2005, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, in coordination with other appropriate State agencies, shall work with the Judiciary to develop training for local judges, juvenile masters, and representatives of relevant local agencies on services available through the public mental health system and the developmental disabilities system and on other available services.”;

in line 19, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”; and in line 20, strike “October 1, 2005” and substitute “December 31, 2005”.
