## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 833 (First Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

In line 2, strike "Motor Vehicle Liability Insurers - Fees" and substitute "<u>Insurance - Fraud</u> <u>Prevention Fee</u>"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 3 down through "Fund" in line 5 and substitute "altering the disbursement of a certain fraud prevention fee collected by the Maryland <u>Insurance Commissioner; requiring a certain amount of the fraud prevention fee be deposited in the</u> <u>Vehicle Theft Prevention Fund to be used for a certain purpose; altering the amount of the fraud</u> <u>prevention fee; making a certain conforming change</u>"; and in line 6, strike "a fee imposed on motor vehicle liability insurers to be paid into the" and substitute "<u>the fraud prevention fee and</u>".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

In line 8, strike "adding to" and substitute "<u>repealing and reenacting, with amendments,</u>"; in line 10, strike "19-517" and substitute "<u>2-505(a), 6-202, and 6-203(a)</u>"; and in line 12, strike "2002" and substitute "<u>2003</u>".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 3

After line 15, insert:

#### "<u>2-505.</u>

(a) There is an Insurance Regulation Fund that consists of:

(1) all revenue received through the imposition and collection of the assessment fee under this subtitle;

(2) all revenue received through the imposition and collection of the fees set forth in § 2-112 of this title;

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(3) [all] TWO-THIRDS OF THE revenue received through the imposition and collection of the fraud prevention fee under Title 6, Subtitle 2 of this article;

(4) <u>all revenue received through the collection of examination expenses under § 2-</u> 208 of this title;

(5) except as provided in § 2-114(a) of this title, all other fees received through the imposition and collection of fees set forth in this article; and

(6) income from investments that the State Treasurer makes for the Fund.

<u>6-202.</u>

(a) The Commissioner shall collect the fraud prevention fee.

(b) [The] OF THE total amount of the fraud prevention fee collected by the Commissioner:

(1) <u>TWO-THIRDS shall be deposited in the Insurance Regulation Fund as</u> provided in § 2-505 of this article; AND

# (2) ONE-THIRD SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE VEHICLE THEFT PREVENTION FUND UNDER § 2-703 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE TO BE USED FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING LOCAL JURISDICTIONS IN PREVENTING VEHICLE THEFT.

<u>6-203.</u>

(a) For each insurer, health maintenance organization, nonprofit health service plan, fraternal benefit society, or any entity operating in the State under the regulatory jurisdiction of the Commissioner other than a premium finance company, a fraternal benefit society that collected less than \$75,000 in premiums in the preceding calendar year, or a motor club, the fraud prevention fee shall be:

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- <u>(1)</u> <u>[\$1,000] \$1,500;</u>
- (2) <u>due on or before June 30 of each year; and</u>
- (3) if applicable, payable with the certificate of authority or license renewal fee.";

and strike in their entirety lines 16 through 22, inclusive.
