AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1323

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Walkup” and substitute “Walkup, Montgomery, Benson, Boutin, Bromwell, Costa, Donoghue, Elliott, Goldwater, Hammen, Hurson, Kullen, Mandel, McDonough, Morhaim, Murray, Nathan-Pulliam, Oaks, Pendergrass, and V. Turner”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 14, strike “but frequently misunderstood”; strike beginning with “Citizens” in line 16 down through “care” in line 18 and substitute “Lyme disease can be difficult to diagnose and treat”; in line 25, strike “long-term”; and in line 26, strike “often” and substitute “may”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, strike beginning with “have” in line 4 down through “severe” in line 5 and substitute “lead to”; in line 12, strike “or because of misdiagnosis”; in line 15, strike “the lack of”; in the same line, strike “misdiagnosis” and substitute “treatment”; in line 16, strike “for testing”; and in line 30, strike “four” and substitute “two”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 3, in line 17, strike “of the misdiagnosis”.
