AMENDMENT NO. 1

In line 2, strike "a Comprehensive" and substitute "<u>an</u>"; strike line 5 in its entirety and substitute "<u>provide, by ordinance, for the regulation, humane treatment, and keeping of domestic animals within the county, including the authority to assess certain penalties for violations of an <u>ordinance; and generally relating to the authority of the Calvert County Commissioners to enact an animal control ordinance.</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 6 through 10, inclusive, and substitute:</u>

"BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions Section 11-504(p) Annotated Code of Maryland (2001 Replacement Volume and 2004 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

Strike in their entirety lines 13 through 16, inclusive, and substitute:

"Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions

<u>11-504.</u>

(p) In addition to and not in substitution for any powers granted under this subtitle, the County Commissioners of Calvert County may by ordinance [or resolution provide for the regulation of dogs and cats within Calvert County] PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION, HUMANE TREATMENT, AND KEEPING OF DOMESTIC ANIMALS WITHIN CALVERT COUNTY, INCLUDING THE AUTHORITY TO ASSESS A PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION OF A PROVISION OF AN ORDINANCE OF IMPRISONMENT IN THE COUNTY JAIL NOT EXCEEDING 30 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.".
