AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 464

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “- Technical Corrections”; and in line 4, after “products;” insert “repealing certain minimum efficiency standards for certain products;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 4 through 12, inclusive.

On page 2, in lines 13 and 21, strike “(4)” and “(5)”, respectively, and substitute “(2)” and “(3)”, respectively.

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 6 and 7; and in lines 8, 16, and 19, strike “(7)”, “(8)”, and “(9)”, respectively, and substitute “(4)”, “(5)”, and “(6)”, respectively.

On page 4, in lines 17, 20, 23, 28, 30, and 33, strike “(10)”, “(11)”, “(12)”, “(13)”, “(14)”, and “(15)”, respectively, and substitute “(7)”, “(8)”, “(9)”, “(10)”, “(11)”, and “(12)”, respectively.

On page 5, in lines 1, 4, 6, 12, 16, and 26, strike “(16)”, “(17)”, “(18)”, “(19)”, “(20)”, and “(21)”, respectively, and substitute “(13)”, “(14)”, “(15)”, “(16)”, “(17)”, and “(18)”, respectively; and strike line 34 in its entirety.

On page 6, in lines 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, strike “(v)”, “(vi)”, “(vii)”, “(viii)”, and “(ix)”, respectively, and substitute “(IV)”, “(V)”, “(VI)”, “(VII)”, and “(VIII)”, respectively; strike in their entirety lines 28 through 33, inclusive; and in line 34, strike “(v)” and substitute “(IV)”.

On page 7, in line 6, 9, 30, and 35, strike “(vi)”, “(vii)”, “(viii)”, and “(ix)”, respectively, and substitute, “(V)”, “(VI)”, “(VII)”, and “(VIII)”, respectively.

(Over)

On page 8, in lines 1 and 12, in each instance, strike “subparagraphs” and substitute “SUBPARAGRAPH”; in line 1, strike “and (iii)”; strike in their entirety lines 6 and 7; in line 8, strike “(iii)” and substitute “(II)”; in line 12, strike “and (iv)”; strike in their entirety lines 17 and 18; and in line 19, strike “(iv)” and substitute “(III)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 9, in line 18, strike “THIS STATE’S” and substitute “THE”; and in line 19, after “STANDARDS” insert “OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND”.
