On page 2, in line 1, after "2-713," insert "2-714,".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 28, after "(<u>C</u>)" insert "(<u>1</u>)"; and after line 31, insert:

"(2) <u>THE BOARD MAY REQUIRE AN ANNUAL INSPECTION IF THE</u> BOARD DETERMINES THAT THE LICENSEE HAS A HISTORY OF VIOLATIONS.

(3) AN UNANNOUNCED INSPECTION SHALL TAKE PLACE WITHIN 48 HOURS AFTER RECEIPT OF A COMPLAINT AGAINST A LICENSEE.";

and after line 33, insert:

"<u>2-714.</u>

(a) <u>A license issued under this subtitle is the property of the State and only is loaned to a licensee.</u>

(b) Each licensee shall display [his] THE LICENSEE'S license conspicuously on the premises where a riding stable is operated by the licensee.

(c) (1) EACH LICENSEE SHALL DISPLAY THE LICENSEE'S LICENSE NUMBER ON A SIGN POSTED ON THE PREMISES WHERE A RIDING STABLE IS OPERATED BY THE LICENSEE.

(2) <u>THE SIGN SHALL BE POSTED AT A HEIGHT AND IN A POSITION</u> <u>THAT CAN BE SEEN CLEARLY FROM A HIGHWAY ADJACENT TO THE ENTRANCE TO</u> <u>THE PREMISES.</u>

(3) <u>THE LICENSE NUMBER ON THE SIGN SHALL BE IN BLACK</u> LETTERS AT LEAST 4 INCHES HIGH ON A WHITE BACKGROUND.

(D) A license issued under this subtitle may not be assigned or transferred.".
