AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 995

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Delegate Hixson” and substitute “Delegates Hixson, Bartlett, Boschert, Bozman, Cardin, Cryor, C. Davis, Elmore, Gilleland, Goodwin, Gordon, Healey, Heller, Howard, Kaiser, King, Marriott, McKee, Myers, Patterson, Ramirez, and Ross”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 13 down through “budget;” in line 14; in line 19, after “agent;” insert “repealing a certain provision of law establishing a principal development initiative in the Baltimore City Public School System;”; and after line 25, insert:

“BY repealing

Article - Education

Section 4-309.1

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2004 Replacement Volume and 2004 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, strike beginning with “IN” in line 31 down through “SYSTEM” in line 34; and in line 35, after “STIPEND;” insert “AND”.

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 4, inclusive; in line 5, strike “(IV)” and substitute “(III)”; in the same line, strike “INCREASE, IF ANY, IN”; and in line 6, after “SALARY” insert “INCLUDING THE STIPEND”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 7 through 12, inclusive; and in lines 13, 19, and 34, strike “(F)”, “(G)”, and “(H)”, respectively, and substitute “(E)”, “(F)”, and “(G)”, respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

(Over)

On page 4, after line 35, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

[4-309.1.

The Department, in consultation with the Baltimore City Public School System, shall design a principal development initiative that will match distinguished principals from outside the system and action support teams with principals in training in the Baltimore City Public School System.]”;

in line 36, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”; in the same line, after “That” insert “Section 2 of”; in line 37, strike “2005” and substitute “2006”; and after line 37, insert:

“SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005.”.
