AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 165

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Kittleman,”; in line 2, strike “a Pay-For-Performance Model” and substitute “Recruitment and Retention Strategies”; in lines 3, 5, and 13, in each instance, after “in” insert “Hard to Staff Public Schools in”; strike beginning with the second “a” in line 4 down through “Model” in line 5 and substitute “Recruitment and Retention Strategies”; in line 9, strike “pay-for-performance models” and substitute “programs”; and in line 12, strike “a Pay-For-Performance Model” and substitute “Recruitment and Retention Strategies”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 16, strike “a Pay-For-Performance Model” and substitute “Recruitment and Retention Strategies”; and in line 17, after “in” insert “Hard to Staff Public Schools in”.

On page 2, in line 17, strike “pay-for-performance”; strike beginning with “Cincinnati,” in line 18 down through “Arizona” in line 19 and substitute “other states”; and strike beginning with “which” in line 21 down through “achievement” in line 22 and substitute “to implement successful research-based recruitment and retention strategies”.
