AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 205, AS AMENDED

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 3 of the Budget and Taxation Committee Amendments (SB0205/529530/1), in line 14 of Amendment No. 1, after “purposes;” insert “requiring that certain distributions from video lottery proceeds be made to a certain special fund to be used to provide health care coverage to uninsured individuals;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 15 of the Budget and Taxation Committee Amendments, in line 5 of Amendment No. 9, after “(4)” insert “EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION;”; after line 6, insert:

“(C) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, AFTER THE DISTRIBUTIONS UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(1) THROUGH (3) OF THIS SECTION, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL PAY THE REMAINING PROCEEDS OF VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINALS AT EACH VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY AS FOLLOWS:

(1) 25% TO A SPECIAL FUND, TO BE USED ONLY TO PROVIDE HEALTH CARE COVERAGE TO UNINSURED INDIVIDUALS IN THE STATE; AND

(2) 75% TO THE EDUCATION TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 9-1A-29 OF THIS SUBTITLE.”;

and in line 7, strike “(C)” and substitute “(D)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 16 of the Budget and Taxation Committee Amendments, in line 4 of Amendment No. 11, strike “\$150,000,000”; and in line 6, after “BASIS” insert “:

(Over)

- (1) AT LEAST \$150,000,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007;
- (2) AT LEAST \$300,000,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008; AND

(3) AT LEAST \$350,000,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER THROUGH FISCAL 2014”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 21 of the Budget and Taxation Committee Amendments, in the last line of Amendment No. 14, strike “30%” and substitute “17%”; and on page 22, in line 4, strike “36%” and substitute “20%”.
