## AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL NO. 625

(First Reading File Bill)

On page 1, strike beginning with "Authority" in line 2 down through "Duties" in line 3 and substitute "Advisory Committee"; and strike beginning with "Chesapeake" in line 4 down through "Authority." in line 24 and substitute "Chesapeake Bay Crossing Advisory Committee; specifying the membership of the committee; providing for the terms of the members of the committee; providing for the election of the chair of the committee; prohibiting a member of the committee from receiving certain compensation; specifying the duties of the committee; requiring the committee to make certain reports to the Maryland Transportation Authority and the General Assembly; and generally relating to the Chesapeake Bay Crossing Advisory Committee.

## BY adding to

Article - Transportation

Section 4-210

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2001 Replacement Volume and 2004 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## **Article - Transportation**

<u>4-210.</u>

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ADVISORY COMMITTEE" MEANS THE CHESAPEAKE BAY CROSSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE.
- (B) THERE IS A CHESAPEAKE BAY CROSSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE IN THE AUTHORITY.

- (C) THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:
- (1) THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY OF THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY;
  - (2) TWO MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;
- (3) TWO MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES; AND
  - (4) THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR:
    - (I) THREE MEMBERS WHO LIVE IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY;
    - (II) THREE MEMBERS WHO LIVE IN QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY;

AND

- (III) TWO MEMBERS WHO ARE FAMILIAR WITH ISSUES FACED BY COMMUTERS WHO CROSS THE CHESAPEAKE BAY.
- (D) (1) <u>EACH APPOINTED MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE</u> <u>SERVES FOR A TERM OF 3 YEARS AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.</u>
- (2) THE TERMS OF THE APPOINTED MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE ON JULY 1, 2005.
- (E) THE MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ANNUALLY SHALL ELECT A MEMBER TO SERVE AS CHAIR OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.
- (F) THE AUTHORITY SHALL PROVIDE STAFF FOR THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.
  - (G) A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE:
    - (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

- (2) <u>IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE</u> STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
  - (H) THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL:
- (1) STUDY ISSUES ASSOCIATED WITH TRAFFIC ON THE WILLIAM PRESTON LANE, JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE AND PARALLEL CHESAPEAKE BAY BRIDGE; AND
- (2) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE AUTHORITY REGARDING WAYS TO IMPROVE THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC ON THE WILLIAM PRESTON LANE, JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE AND PARALLEL CHESAPEAKE BAY BRIDGE.
- (I) (1) THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL REPORT ITS ACTIVITIES AND RECOMMENDATIONS QUARTERLY TO THE AUTHORITY.
- (2) THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL REPORT ITS ACTIVITIES AND RECOMMENDATIONS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON OR BEFORE JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR.".

On pages 1 through 19, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 25 on page 1 through line 9 on page 19, inclusive, and substitute:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial members of the Chesapeake Bay Crossing Advisory Committee shall expire as follows:

- (1) four members in 2006;
- (2) four members in 2007; and
- (3) four members in 2008.

  SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1,

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<u>2005.</u>".
