AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 705

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 10, after “facilities;” insert “exempting certain subdivisions from the adequate public facilities ordinance;”; and strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 13 down through “fees;” in line 14.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, strike beginning with the colon in line 6 down through “(III)” in line 13; in line 14, after “REGULATIONS” insert “, ST. MARY’S COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS;”; in line 18, after “REGULATIONS” insert “, ST. MARY’S COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS;”; and strike beginning with the colon in line 20 down through “DEVELOPMENT;” in line 26 and substitute “IT MEETS THE STATE AND COUNTY REQUIREMENTS FOR STORMWATER MANAGEMENT.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 27 on page 3 through line 21 on page 4, inclusive.

On page 4, in line 22, strike “(10)” and substitute “(6)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 4, in line 32, after “(3)” insert “(I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH;”; after line 34, insert:

“(II) MINOR SUBDIVISIONS OF 3 LOTS OR LESS ARE EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE ADEQUATE PUBLIC FACILITIES ORDINANCE.”;

and in line 36, strike “OF PLAN APPROVAL” and substitute “THE USE AND OCCUPANCY”

PERMIT IS ISSUED".

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 5, in line 2, after "CONSIDERED" insert "UNLESS BONDING HAS BEEN APPROVED FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS"; in line 3, strike "THAT DO NOT DIRECTLY CORRECT" and substitute "OF"; in line 4, strike "SPECIFIC TO A PROPOSED SUBDIVISION OR DEVELOPMENT" and substitute "IN SCHOOL FACILITIES"; and strike beginning with "(A)" in line 12 down through "(B)" in line 16.
