AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 866

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “On Farm” and substitute “On-Farm”; in lines 4, 6, and 7, in each instance, strike “on farm” and substitute “on-farm”; in line 5, strike “may operate” and substitute “is located on a farm, serves certain foods, and operates”; in the same line, strike “days each year” and substitute “consecutive days, subject to certain renewal authority”; and in the same line, after “expiration” insert “and renewal”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 21, strike “ON FARM” and substitute “ON-FARM”; in line 22, strike “THAT IS” and substitute “THAT:

(I) IS”;

in the same line, strike “AND” and substitute “;

(II) SERVES FOOD AS DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT; AND

(III)”;

in line 23, strike “CALENDAR” and substitute “CONSECUTIVE”; and in the same line, strike “EACH YEAR” and substitute “WITH UP TO TWO RENEWALS IN A 1-YEAR PERIOD”.

On page 2, in line 2, strike “paragraph (2)” and substitute “PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3)”; in line 3, strike “AND AN ON FARM FOOD SERVICE FACILITY LICENSE”; after line 10, insert:

“(3) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 10-226 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, A LICENSE TO OPERATE AN ON-FARM FOOD SERVICE

FACILITY EXPIRES AFTER 30 CONSECUTIVE DAYS UNLESS IT IS RENEWED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH.

(II) AN ON-FARM FOOD SERVICE FACILITY MAY RENEW AN ON-FARM FOOD SERVICE FACILITY LICENSE UP TO TWO TIMES WITHIN A 1-YEAR PERIOD.”;

and in line 12, after “facility,” insert “OR AN ON-FARM FOOD SERVICE FACILITY,”.
