(4) <u>a member of the police department, bureau, or force of a county;</u>

(6) <u>a member of the Maryland Transit Administration Police Force, Maryland</u> Port Administration Police Force, or Maryland Transportation Authority Police Force;

(12) <u>a member of the Natural Resources Police Force of the Department of Natural</u> <u>Resources;</u>

(13) an authorized employee of the Field Enforcement Division of the Comptroller's Office;

(14) <u>a member of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission</u> Park Police:

(15) <u>a member of the Housing Authority of Baltimore City Police Force;</u>

(16) <u>a member of the Crofton Police Department;</u>

(18) <u>a member of the Internal Investigative Unit of the Department;</u>

(19) a member of the State Forest and Park Service Police Force of the Department of Natural Resources:
