## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Practice of Law" and substitute "<u>Attorneys-at-Law</u>"; in line 3, after the first "of" insert "<u>providing that a judge of the Orphans' Court in Baltimore County who is also an attorney-at-law shall have full power to do any act that the court is authorized by law to perform, including the power to hold court under certain circumstances;"; in line 5, strike "and the practice of law"; and in line 8, after "Section" insert "<u>2-106 (f) and</u>".</u>

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 13, insert:

## "<u>2-106.</u>

(f) (1) The sessions of the Court in Baltimore County shall continue from 10 a.m. to4 p.m., if necessary for the transaction of the business of the Court.

(2) <u>A JUDGE OF THE ORPHANS' COURT IN BALTIMORE COUNTY WHO</u> <u>IS ALSO AN ATTORNEY-AT-LAW HAS FULL POWER TO DO ANY ACT THAT THE</u> <u>COURT IS AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO PERFORM, INCLUDING THE POWER TO HOLD</u> <u>COURT ON A DAY NOT NAMED IN AN ADJOURNMENT.</u>".
