AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 207

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after “of” insert “altering the time period for which the Motor Vehicle Administration is required to suspend the license to drive of a person who is adjudicated delinquent or found to have committed a delinquent act without an adjudication of delinquency by reason of a violation of certain alcohol- or drug-related driving offenses;”; and strike beginning with “requiring” in line 8 down through “circumstances;” in line 9.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 11, strike the bracket; in line 12, strike “] REVOKE”; strike beginning with “UNDER” in line 12 down through “ARTICLE” in line 13; in line 14, strike “OR”; in line 15, strike the bracket; in line 16, in each instance, strike the bracket; in the same line, strike “SUSPEND”; in the same line, strike “6 months” and substitute “1 YEAR”; and strike beginning with “1 year” in line 19 down through “OLD” in line 20 and substitute “2 YEARS”.

On page 4, strike beginning with “FOR” in line 8 down through “YEARS” in line 11 and substitute “:

(I) FOR 1 YEAR FOR A FIRST VIOLATION OF § 21-902(B) OR (C) OF THIS ARTICLE; AND

(II) FOR 2 YEARS FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION OF § 21-902(B) OR (C) OF THIS ARTICLE”.

On page 9, strike in their entirety lines 12 through 20, inclusive; and in line 21, strike “(8)” and substitute “(7)”.
