AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 257

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 23, strike “providing for the expiration of the terms of” and substitute “authorizing”; and in line 24, after “Act” insert “to continue serving until the expiration of certain terms”.

On pages 1 and 2, strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 24 on page 1 down through “commissioner” in line 1 on page 2 and substitute “providing for the rotating appointment of certain commissioners”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 6, in line 8, strike “the term of office of”; strike beginning with “expire” in line 10 down through “Women” in line 12 and substitute “continue to serve until the end of that member’s term”; and strike beginning with the first “the” in line 13 down through “Delegates” in line 27 and substitute “on June 1, 2005, the Governor shall appoint one member in accordance with Article 49C, § 2(b)(2)(i) of the Code, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act. Additional appointments to fill existing vacancies as of June 1, 2005 and future vacancies that occur at the end of each member’s term, shall be made on a rotating basis in the following order:

- (1) one member in accordance with Article 49C, § 2(b)(1)(i) of the Code;
- (2) one member in accordance with Article 49C, § 2(b)(1)(ii) of the Code;
- (3) one member in accordance with Article 49C, § 2(b)(1)(iii) of the Code;
- (4) one member in accordance with Article 49C, § 2(b)(2)(i) of the Code;
- (5) one member in accordance with Article 49C, § 2(b)(2)(ii) of the Code; and

(Over)

(6) one member in accordance with Article 49C, § 2(b)(2)(iii) of the Code".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 6, in line 33, strike "October" and substitute "June".
