On page 23, in line 28, strike "OR" and substitute "AND".

On page 24, in lines 8 and 12, in each instance, strike "2003" and substitute "2005"; after line 23, insert:

- "(G) (1) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE BOARD MAY WAIVE ANY REQUIREMENT OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS REGISTERED OR HAS WORKED AS A PHARMACY TECHNICIAN IN ANY OTHER STATE.

- (I) PAYS THE APPLICATION FEE REQUIRED BY THE BOARD UNDER § 12-6B-03 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- (II) 1. PROVIDES ADEQUATE EVIDENCE THAT THE APPLICANT BECAME REGISTERED IN THE OTHER STATE UNDER REQUIREMENTS SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO THE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE; OR
- <u>2. HAS WORKED AS A PHARMACY TECHNICIAN IN THE</u>
 OTHER STATE AND CAN SATISFY ANY REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED IN
 REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD.";

in line 32, strike "<u>OR</u>" and substitute "<u>AND</u>"; and in line 34, after "<u>12-6B-02(B)(4)(I)</u>" insert "<u>OF</u> THIS SUBTITLE".

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 25, in line 12, strike "<u>CERTIFICATES</u>" and substitute "<u>REGISTRATIONS</u>"; and in line 14, strike "CERTIFYING" and substitute "REGISTERING".

On page 33, in line 2, strike "certification" and substitute "registration".
