AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 188

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Crimes and”; strike beginning with “prohibiting” in line 3 down through “crimes;” in line 26 and substitute “providing that a certain court does not have jurisdiction over a certain person who engages in certain types of obstruction of justice;”; and in line 29, strike “crimes against victims and witnesses” and substitute “victim and witness intimidation”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 30 on page 1 through line 9 on page 2, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 2 through 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 27 on page 2 through line 12 on page 5, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 5, in line 29, strike “OR ACQUIESCED”; in the same line, after “IN” insert “2 DIRECTED, OR CONSENTED TO”; and in line 33, after “SECTION” insert “2”.
